Among knots that lie on the genus 2 Heegaard surface for S^3 , two classes of knots, the primitive/primitive and primitive/Seifert knots, are of particular interest because they admit lens space surgeries and Seifert fibered surgeries, respectively. The primitive/primitive knots were introduced by Berge; the primitive/Seifert knots, introduced by Dean, are a natural generalization of the primitive/primitive knots. In Berge's work, he classified the primitive/primitive knots. In this talk, I will discuss work, joint with John Berge and Sungmo Kang, to classify the primitive/Seifert knots.
