These totals must be received to make use of the individual data listed above.

Note:

The one Assistant Professor whose full-time academic-year salary is reported between \$40,000 and \$45,000 is the one on a 11-12 month appointment. His salary for the appointment is \$52,000, but this figure is multiplied by 0.8 to reach the equivalent academic-year salary of \$41,600 reported on this form.

The one Full Professor whose full-time academic-year salary is reported between \$95,000 and \$100,000 is half-time (0.5 FTE) in the department but full-time at the university.
